AMBULANCE DRIVER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Operates an ambulance in the transportation of the sick and injured to hospitals or other health facilities. This is routine, but responsible work, requiring the ability to operate an ambulance under emergency conditions. Assignments involve considerable care when loading, transporting and delivering patients. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Town Supervisor, however, Ambulance Drivers are responsible for the safe and efficient operation of their equipment. The incumbent performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Operates an ambulance, transporting patients from fires, accidents and scenes of disaster to hospitals, doctor's offices and homes;
Maintains records of ambulance calls and operations;
Maintains records of miles driven and preventive maintenance;
Prepares reports as required;
May administer first aid and assist physicians at accident scenes.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the operation of ambulances; good knowledge of the geography of the operating jurisdictions; working knowledge of first aid practices; ability to operate an ambulance safely and efficiently in traffic and under adverse weather conditions; ability to get along well with others.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Six (6) months in the operation of automotive equipment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of an appropriate level, valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
