- WHEREAS, All conditions precedent to the financing of the capital project hereinafter described, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, have been performed, and
- WHEREAS, It is now desired to authorize the financing of such capital project, now, therefore, be it hereby
- **RESOLVED,** By the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the County Legislature of the County of Oneida, New York, as follows:
  - <u>Section 1.</u> The repair, renovation and upgrade of the HVAC system at the Public Safety Complex and Correctional Facility in and for Oneida County, including incidental expenses, is hereby authorized at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,009,800.
  - <u>Section 2.</u> The plan for financing of such maximum estimated cost is by the issuance of \$1,009,800 bonds of Oneida County hereby authorized to be issued therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law.
  - <u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is ten years, pursuant to subdivision 13 of paragraph "a" of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.
  - Section 4. The faith and credit of Oneida County, are hereby irrevocable pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent not paid from other sources, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of Oneida County, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

<u>Section 5.</u> Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the County Comptroller, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said County Comptroller, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the serial bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the County Comptroller, the chief fiscal officer of Oneida County. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the County Comptroller shall determine with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

<u>Section 7.</u> The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- 1. Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which Oneida County is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2. The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with.
- 3. Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

<u>Section 8.</u> This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

<u>Section 9.</u> This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in summary form in the Observer Dispatch and in the Rome Sentinel, the official newspapers of Oneida County, together with a notice of the Clerk of the County Legislature in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
