- WHEREAS, the 2020 2021 UPWP was approved on February 27, 2020 by HOCTS Resolution 2020 1 of the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee; and
- **WHEREAS**, the reduction of funds is from the allocated backlog, as these funds were spent in the 2019-2020 program year, but not reflected in the estimated budget at the time of UPWP adoption in March 2020; and
- WHEREAS, funds were reduced in the following categories, travel, equipment, supplies/reproduction, contractual, and other incidental expenses; and

Amendment to the 2020 – 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) to include Appendix C – Expanded Project Listing

- WHEREAS, the Herkimer Oneida Counties Transportation Study (HOCTS) is designated by the Governor of New York State as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Utica-Rome Metropolitan Planning Area; and

- WHEREAS, Title 23, Section 134 of the United States Code further requires that an LRTP shall, at a minimum, identify transportation facilities that should function as an integrated system and include a fiscally-constrained financial plan with an associated project listing for implementation of recommendations contained in the LRTP; and
- WHEREAS, HOCTS, in consultation with stakeholders and the public, has developed the 2020 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan "Going Places" in a manner that met the requirements of Title 23, Section 134 of the United States Code; and

- WHEREAS, the LRTP has been exposed to a public input, review, comment period, and public hearing in accordance with Title 23, Section 134 of the United States Code and as prescribed in HOCTS Public Participation Plan 2016 Update and has been found to afford a public participation process that ensured equal opportunity for public involvement of all persons in the transportation planning process; and
- WHEREAS, the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee (GP&L) previously approved the 2020 - 2024 LRTP in December 2019 by HOCTS Resolution 2019 - 27; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that to conform with the requirements of FHWA and to ensure consistency between the LRTP, Transportation Improvement Program, and Unified Planning Work Program, the attached, Appendix C – Expanded Projecting Listing amends the project listing to afford greater detail where available for individual projects; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Appendix C Expanded Projecting Listing may be periodically amended to account for unforeseen changes in project progression and priorities; and

2021 Traffic Safety Performance Measures Targets

- WHEREAS, the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Study has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Herkimer-Oneida County Urbanized and approved Metropolitan Planning Areas; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) final rule (23 CFR Part 490) requires States to set targets for five safety performance measures; and
- **WHEREAS**, the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has established targets for five safety performance measures based on five year rolling averages for:
 - (1) Number of Fatalities,
 - (2) Rate of Fatalities per 100 million Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT),
 - (3) Number of Serious Injuries,
 - (4) Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million VMT, and
 - (5) Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Non-motorized Serious Injuries; and
- WHEREAS, the NYSDOT coordinated the establishment of safety targets with the fourteen Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) in New York through the New York State Association of Metropolitan Planning Organizations (NYSAMPO) Safety Working Group, the NYSAMPO Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act Working Group, discussed the targets at a Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Safety Target Setting Workshop, and during an Executive Director's meeting; and
- **WHEREAS**, the NYSDOT incorporated the safety targets in the Highway Safety Annual Report due to the Federal Highway Administration by

August 31, 2020, and the Governors Traffic Safety Committee has adopted identical safety targets for number of fatalities, rate of fatalities and number of serious injuries as set forth in the Highway Safety Strategic Plan (HSSP); and

- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee agrees to support NYSDOT's 2021 targets for the five safety performance targets as attached herein; and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee will plan and program projects that contribute to the accomplishment of the safety targets; and
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the GP&L Committee hereby directs the Chairman to communicate this action to the appropriate State and Federal officials in the prescribed manner.


