

About the Grant Program

The Oneida County Flood Mitigation Grant funding is inherently flexible and can be used for a variety of projects. Grant applications need a local match, which can include in-kind labor and equipment or other state and/or federal grant funds. Successful applicants can receive funds with a 50/50 matching grant funds from Oneida County for projects under \$100,000 in value and 75/25 match for projects over \$100,000. This year, applications will be due in August 31, 2020. Funding for successful projects is expected in Winter 2020.
