Apparatus Operator-Emergency Vehicle Operation

Apparatus Operator –Emergency Vehicle Operation: Provides vehicle operators with a better understanding of the seriousness of emergency vehicle operation. Based on objectives from national Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1002 Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator, Chapter 2, this course stimulated the thought processes to make student aware of the potential for tragedy and financial loss and of the legal and moral responsibilities encountered when operating an emergency vehicle.

The course consists of 18 hours of training presented on as follows:
