## Fire Behavior and Arson Awareness

**Fire Behavior and Arson Awareness** train's firefighters to understand normal and predicted fire behavior. It enables students to understand the basic concepts of fire chemistry, the normal growth of fires and to develop and apply observational skills that may be critical to fire investigation. Using stand accepted procedures, students apply techniques fundamental to preserving the fire scene for further cause determination.

The course consists of 12 hours of training presented on as follows:

Class starts at 8 A.M. Saturdays and 6:30 pm Weeknights.
