Fire Police

Fire Police: Trains fire police to perform their duties more effectively. It includes defining and interpreting terms, oath of office, relation to regular police officers, general duties, maintaining safe conditions at an emergency traffic direction and control, pre-planning, and various laws of interest to the fire service. Under the provision of General Municipal Law, Section 209-c, this course, when approved by OFPC, must be completed by every fire Police Officer who was appointed after September 1, 1980.

The course consists of 21 hours of training presented on as follows:

LOCATION: Westmoreland - Nov. 3,4, & 10 at 6:30PM

Oriskany (NY State Preparedness Training Center) - Nov. 13 at 8:00AM to 5:00PM

Class starts at 8 A.M. Saturdays and 6:30 pm Weeknights.

UNLESS OTHERWISE LISTED

Prerequisites: Appointed Fire Police by the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) and Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations. The previous requirement for Scene Support Operations is no longer in effect for this course but may be required by the AHJ. □□□□

Pre-registration is required. Class size is limited to 30 students!

*Equivalencies: Essentials AND Initial Attack or Basic AND Intermediate (be prepared to show proof of any prerequisites)
