National Incident Management Systems **(IS-700 NIMS)**

Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD-5) directed to Secretary of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System. NIMS provides a consistent national wide template to enable all government private-sector, and non-governmental organizations to work together during domestic incidents. This Course will describe the key concepts, principles and benefits of using NIMS.

The course consists of 3 hours of training presented on as follows:
