## NWCG Basic Incident Command System (I-300)

The complexity of incident management, coupled with the growing need for multi-agency and multifunctional involvement on incidents, has increased the need for a single standard incident management system that can be used by all emergency response agencies. Use of the Incident Command System (ICS) by both public safety and private sector organizations continues to increase across the country. The ICS is designed to be used for all applications, fires (wild land and structural), hazardous materials incidents, law enforcement operations, search and rescue operations, air, ground and water accidents, mass casualty incidents, natural disasters and planned events.

The course consists of 20 hours of training presented on as follows:

Class starts at 8 A.M. on Saturdays and 6:30 pm on Week nights

**Prerequisites:** Basic Incident Command System (I-200)

**Pre-registration is required. Class size is limited to 28 students!**
