Principles of Building Construction Combustible: This course introduces basic construction principles and the special characteristics of wood and ordinary construction as they concern the fire service. Primary emphasis is on improving the fire officer's ability to ensure firefighter safety by recognizing common causes and indicators of failure and other hazards related to building construction. Course material enables the fire officer to better predict the overall reaction of a building to fire conditions.

The course consists of 12 hours of training presented on as follows:

Prerequisites: Scene Support Operations or equivalent
