Who Needs This Class?

As of April 22, 2010, all contractors working in pre-1978 housing, schools, or child-occupied facilities are required to obtain an EPA firm license and have their workers trained in lead-safe work practices, or face fines by the EPA. This course is accredited by the EPA and fulfills the requirement for lead-safety training.

Initial Lead Renovators Certification

This 8-hour initial certification course is required for any renovators without previous training to become a certified lead-safe contractor. Bring pencil and paper; all other materials provided. The course concludes with a 25-question exam. Cost: \$195
