Directions to MVCC:

From the East or West

1. Take I 90 to Exit 31 (Utica).
2. After the toll booth, follow Route 790 to Rte 12.
3. Take Route 12 South to the Burrstone Road exit.
4. Follow the exit ramp to Burrstone Road.
5. Stay in the right lane on Burrstone Road and continue across Genesee Street. You will be on Memorial Parkway East.
6. Follow Memorial Parkway approximately 3 miles.
7. At the intersection of Sherman Drive and Memorial Parkway, turn left.
8. MVCC will be on your right.

From the North

1. Follow Route 12 South into Utica.
2. Get off at the Burrstone Road exit.
3. Follow the exit ramp to Burrstone Road.
4. Stay in the right lane on Burrstone Road and continue across Genesee Street. You will be on Memorial Parkway East.
5. Follow Memorial Parkway approximately 3 miles.
6. At the intersection of Sherman Drive and Memorial Parkway, turn left.
7. MVCC will be on your right.

From the South

1. Follow Route 12 North into Utica.
2. Get off at the Burrstone Road exit.
3. Follow the exit ramp to Burrstone Road.
4. Stay in the right lane on Burrstone Road and continue across Genesee Street. You will be on Memorial Parkway East.
5. Follow Memorial Parkway approximately 3 miles.
6. At the intersection of Sherman Drive and Memorial Parkway, turn left.
7. MVCC will be on your right.

**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW
ACT (SEQRA) BASICS**
