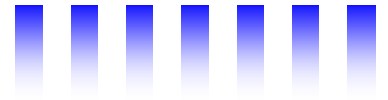
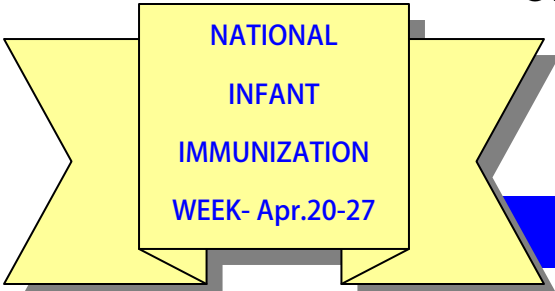

**NYSIIS-** Article 21, Title 6 of PHL 2186 signed law August 2006 mandates that as of January 1, 2008, all current and historic immunizations administered to children < 19 yrs. must be entered in NYSIIS within 14 days of administration. Here are useful NYSIIS link:

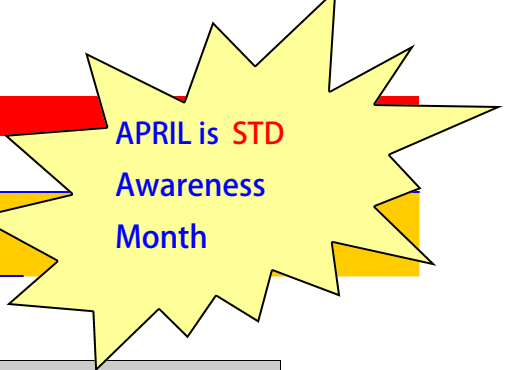
